- Investigate and provide logistics input to programs and program acquisition documents including; Acquisition Strategy (AS), Acquisition Program Baseline (APB), Initial Capabilities Document (ICD), Capabilities Development Document (CDD) and Integrated Master Schedules for programs in development
- Provide technical input and develop/update and maintain the Logistics Requirements Funding Summary (LRFS), Integrated Logistics Support Plan (ILSP) and Users Logistics Support Summary (ULSS).
- Provide technical input and develop/update/maintain the production Navy Training System Plan (NTSP).
- Provide technical input and update the production Training System Plan (TSP) and/or develop the Training Planning Process Methodology (TRPPM).
- Develop and prepare for review technical briefing material for Independent Logistics Assessments (ILAs).
- Provide ILS planning in support of program Engineering Changes (ECs) and Field Changes (FCs) as well as Configuration Change Board (CCB)/Change Request (CR) logistics reviews.
- Provide technical representation at working group meetings, IPT sessions, and in-process reviews and provide appropriate reports.
- Provide developmental technical, training and developmental planning support.

Qualifications/Experience

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Engineering, Business Management, Business Administration, Management, Logistics, Information Systems Technologies or Public Administration) and five (5) years of experience in direct Integrated Logistics.
- DAWIA Level II Logistics or equivalent certification may be substituted for Bachelor's requirement.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen. Secret Clearance required.
- Must possess excellent communication skills (verbal and written) and able to work independently and as part of a team.
